



Oregon Adopt-A-River 2016 – Project Report Summary



Throughout 2016, more than **1,538 volunteers** made a very positive collective impact for Oregon waterways with SOLVE's support. People from all walks of life gathered to make a difference along rivers, streams, and lakes across the state.

Oregon Adopt-A-River year by the numbers:

- **122 adoptions covering 551 miles of waterway**
- **132 organized cleanup events**
- **28,019 pounds of trash and recycling disposed of properly**
- **54 tires removed**

Project highlights included the annual Rogue River Cleanup near Gold Beach, where 115 volunteers came together to remove 3 tons of trash from this special Oregon River. Along the Molalla River 61 volunteers dedicated a morning to cleaning up trash from miles of riverbank, collecting close to 1,600 pounds of trash. In Southern Oregon a group of Umpqua Community College students visited the Umpqua River and removed 600 pounds of trash.
